

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-06

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SMOKING POLICY IN CITY HALL; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING FURTHER ACTIONS IN CONFORMANCE THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, THE Board of Aldermen of the City of New Florence, Missouri (the “City”) has determined that the adoption and implementation of a policy governing smoking in City Hall is in the best interest of the City and its residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF NEW FLORENCE, MISSOURI as follows:

Section 1. That the Policy governing smoking in City Hall, as set forth on Exhibit A, attached to and incorporated by reference in this Resolution (the “City Smoking in City Hall” policy is hereby approved and adopted.

Section 2. That “Smoking in City Hall” Policy shall be included within the City’s Policies and Procedures manual (Handbook).

Section 3. That the portions of the Resolution shall be severable. In the event that any portion of this Resolution is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the remaining portions of this Resolution are valid, unless the court finds the valid portions of this Resolution are so essential and inseparably connected with and dependent upon the void portion that it cannot be presumed that the Board of Aldermen of the City has enacted the valid portions without the invalid ones, or unless the court finds that the valid portions standing alone are incomplete and are incapable of being executed in accordance with the legislative intent.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
